Nestled in a beautiful picturesque rural setting providing far reaching views across the adjoining countryside to the glorious North Devon coastline with Hartland point and Lundy Island in the distance. This charming 15th century detached farm house with separate holiday cottages offers a unique opportunity for those seeking a peaceful and private lifestyle whilst earning a living. The main house boasts four spacious double bedrooms, two with ensuite bathrooms that help to provide ample accommodation for a growing family or those who eniov hosting quests. The current owners have also run a very successful bed and breakfast business from the house but in latter years have concentrated more so on the holiday cottage side of the business. The property exudes a sense of sophistication and style whilst retaining the stunning character features of yesteryear adding yet further to its charm. With well-maintained interiors and its inviting atmosphere there's an awful lot to like.

The old barn has been converted into two holiday cottages, each having two bedrooms on the ground floor and an open plan living on the first floor allowing panoramic views of the countryside from a more elevated position, they also have outside garden / patio areas.

If you are looking to maximise the income potential on site, there is a ring fenced 0.5 acre Motorhome and Caravan Club CL site used for touring caravans and motor homes complete with five electric hook-up points.

There is lots to do for your quests both regionally and locally to help attract booking year round. Within just a mile and a half you have the Plough arts centre / theatre, Dartington Crystal and The Royal Horticultural society gardens "Rosemoor" a little further on. Within a couple of miles you can find yourself on the Tarka trail, a footpath/cycle way mainly built on the bed of a disused railway where all the gradients are gentle. It winds its way through some stunning woodland along the course of the River Torridge past Beam Weir, where Henry Williamson's Tarka the Otter was born, from which the trail gains its name. It continues past Bideford and along the coast to Barnstaple where it splits and one leg turns inland again following the portion of the railway which is still in use the other continues on the bed of the disused railway and onto Ilfracombe. Both Dartmoor and Exmoor national parks are within an hour's drive away. The closest coastline at Westward Ho! is only a short car journey away and is very popular with surfers and body borders alike.

All in all this is a fantastic opportunity for your dream move to the country allowing you to enjoy everything our wonderful County has to offer whilst earning a living. 












#### **Directions**
