A felling licence is currently in place, expiring on 15th Oct 2026 allowing for an effective thinning programme to yield an income before re-planting for future years to come. There is an attractive mix of hard and softwood on site from a variety of specimens that include European larch, Scots pine, Beech, Western hemlock, Japanese larch, western red cedar and Sequoia, the latter of which is famous for its very large specimens in California.

There is a five bar gated access onto the site from the lane where ample space for parking multiple vehicles is found along with various storage structures and wood stores. The woodland is easy to navigate with two stoned tracks running through both the centre and the Eastern boundary.

A small stream to the Northern boundary adds to this beautiful woodlands charm and enjoyment, it really is a wonderful retreat not to be missed.
