Overview

Situated in the heart of the historic market town of Holsworthy, this charming former railway cottage offers characterful accommodation with a wealth of original features. The glazed frontage leads into a welcoming living room, complete with a multi-fuel stove set within a feature fireplace. To the rear is the kitchen which provides direct access to a courtyard garden, where you will find an outside WC, a useful storage shed, and a traditional coal bunker.



Upstairs, the property offers a generous double bedroom and a bathroom fitted with a bath, shower over, WC, and wash hand basin.

While the property would benefit from a degree of modernisation, it presents an excellent opportunity for first-time buyers, investors, or those seeking to downsize. Offered to the market with no onward chain.

Location

The bustling market town of Holsworthy has a weekly Pannier Market, good range of national and local shops together with a Waitrose supermarket, BP filling station, Marks & Spencers Simply Food and Wild Bean café. There are a whole range of amenities within the town including a heated swimming pool, sports hall, bowling green, cricket club, 18 hole golf course etc. Bude on the North Cornish coast is some 9 miles. Okehampton, Dartmoor National Park and the market town of Bideford are some 20 miles distant, whilst Barnstaple, the Regional North Devon Centre is some 30 miles. Launceston, Cornwall's ancient capital, is some 14 miles distant. Holsworthy is in the heart of "Ruby Country", named after the famous local Red Ruby cattle.


