Occupying an elevated position on New Guineaport in Wadebridge, this charming three-bedroom terraced home offers spacious and versatile accommodation arranged over three floors, enjoying stunning views across the River Camel and surrounding estuary.

Upon entering the property, you are welcomed by a large entrance hallway providing access to the principal living spaces and staircase to the upper floors. The living room is a bright and inviting space, beautifully enhanced by a bay window overlooking the River Camel, allowing an abundance of natural light to flood the room whilst the elevated outlook creates a wonderful sense of openness.

To the rear of the property is a generously sized open-plan kitchen/dining room, ideal for both everyday family living and entertaining guests. The dining area comfortably accommodates a large dining table and benefits from additional cupboard storage alongside a traditional Aga, creating a warm and characterful focal point.

The kitchen itself offers ample worktop and cupboard space, together with room for integrated appliances. Leading from the kitchen is a practical utility room complete with a separate sink and space for both a washing machine and tumble dryer, with direct access out to the rear garden.

The first floor comprises a spacious family bathroom fitted with both a bath and separate walk-in shower, alongside two well-proportioned double bedrooms. The front-facing bedroom benefits from an en suite shower room, built-in wardrobes and enjoys stunning views across the river estuary and surrounding countryside.

Occupying the top floor is a further generous double bedroom, complete with three Velux windows that allow plenty of natural light to pour in, creating a bright and airy retreat.

Externally, the property continues to impress with a delightful tiered rear garden featuring a patio seating area, gravelled and bedding sections and a garden shed positioned at the top of the garden. To the front, a large gravelled area with raised flower beds adds to the property's kerb appeal. The home also enjoys uninterrupted views towards the local cricket grounds, playing fields and Camel Estuary, providing a truly special setting, as well as offering direct access to the long distance Camel Trail.

Offered to the market with no onward chain, this fantastic home presents an excellent opportunity to acquire a characterful and well-positioned property in the heart of Wadebridge.

Combining a lively community, beautiful surroundings, and excellent accessibility, Wadebridge continues to be one of North Cornwall's most desirable places to live.

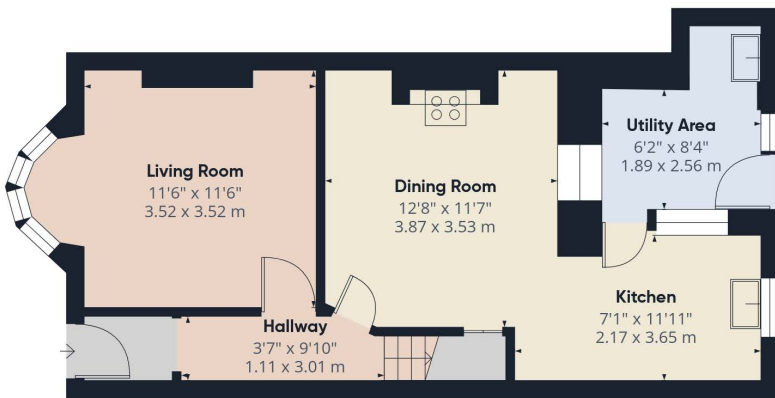

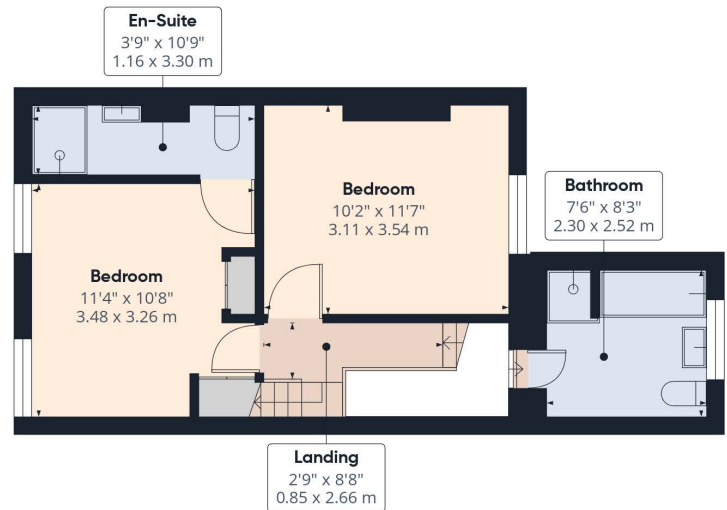

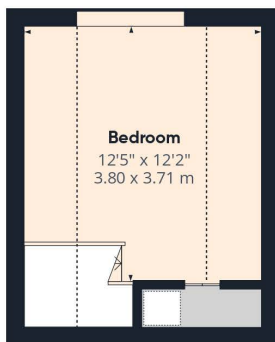
