I refer to your application for consent to the discharge of effluent from the above premises.

Our records indicate that Consent No. CN 1800/2007 was issued to Mr on 14 June 2007 to permit a discharge of sewage effluent from a package treatment plant to the waterway via underground stratum at the above site. I enclose a copy of the consent, together with a copy of the approved plan submitted with the application. Under the terms of the Water (Northern Ireland) Order 1999 the existing consent is still valid.

Should the applicant wish to carry out the development as shown on the previous consent a further application will not be necessary and, under the circumstances, you may wish to withdraw the application for consent and seek a refund of the application fee of £110 from Northern Ireland Environment Agency in favour of the existing consent and, alternatively, make an application for review of consent to transfer ownership of the existing consented premises at a fee of £30.

It is noted, however, that the site plans accompanying the current application would indicate an amended siting of the package treatment plant and it may be necessary to review the existing consent if it is not the applicant's intention to install the system in accordance with the previous consent.

I would be pleased if you could contact this office as soon as possible in order to advise whether you wish to withdraw the current application or alternatively, should the applicant wish to proceed with the application, it will be processed as a review application to reflect a change in position of the package treatment plant and transfer of ownership.
